Description

BLISS Imobiliare presents the villa "Carola" in Sinaia, which is on the list of historical monuments in Prahova County, which are inscribed in the National Cultural Heritage of Romania.

Villa "Carola", one of the oldest buildings in Sinaia, completed in 1896, has a usable area of 1.053 square meters with 39 rooms, 5 bathrooms and a plot of 1.593 square meters.

Located in the Furnica district, close to Peles Castle, Villa "Carola" in Sinaia is a living history lesson. Built in the style specific to the resort, inspired by the architecture of Peles, the villa was the site of famous love stories and hosted world celebrities.

Select and chic location, the hotel would be the secret meeting place of lovers Elena Lupescu and Carol, the crown prince. The two had met in February 1925, and Villa "Carola", Elena Lupescu's residence at the time, was to be the secret meeting place.

The history of the villa is related to the beginnings of tourist life in Sinaia, in the second part of the 19th century. Beautiful and imposing, as interesting as it is history, we suggest you find out its past.

Its first owner, the former valet of Prince Dimitrie Ghica, the Austrian József Ungarth, was in 1870 the first "hotelier" of the commune of Podul Neagului (Sinaia was to be certified as a city on December 1, 1874).

In charge of managing the first hotel in Sinaia, Ungarth would later build his own business, building the Villa "Carola" in 1896.

Luxury and comfort were the key words for all those who retired to Villa Carola, the Austrian knowing how to make each stay as pleasant as possible.

Thus, the garden of the villa was maintained by a gardener, there was a carriage of the boarding house that allowed visitors to walk to the desired locations, and a horse was made available to those who wanted to learn to ride. He also built a restaurant in the courtyard of the villa, the current "Select".

The small hotel is named after József Ungarth's daughter, Carola, who would become Constantin Noica's mother-in-law years later. Philosopher married Wendy Muston, daughter of Walter and Carola Muston, in 1934.

Among the guests received over time was conductor and violinist Yehudi Menuhin. At the age of 11, he spent two months here, during which he attended Vila Luminis, for the violin lessons offered by George Enescu.

The phenomenon makes Sinaia the city with the most historical monuments per capita in Romania.

The property needs renovation to bring it back to its former glory, so that future memories can be lived and written down in history!

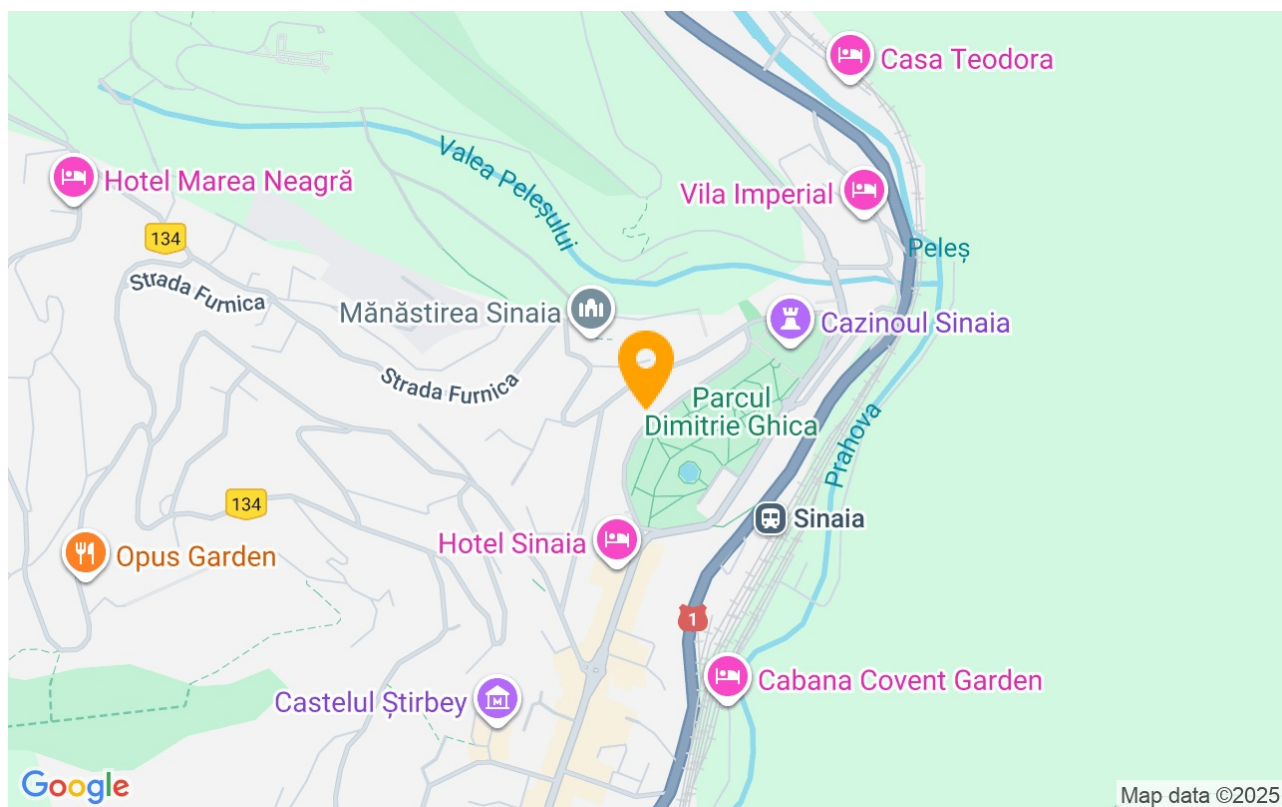
